



DETENTION AND DEMURRAGE RULES

1. General definition

Detention: The period in which carrier's container is on hold by the shipper/consignee.

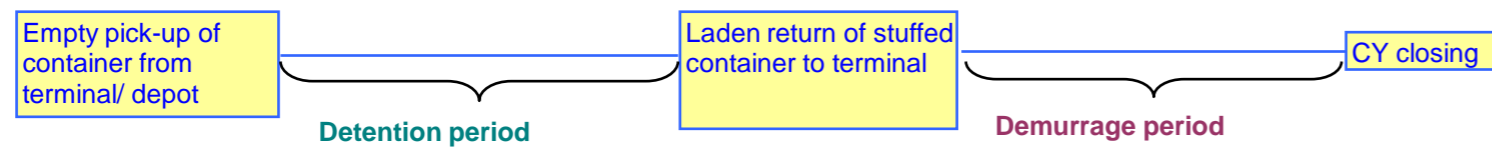
Demurrage: The period in which shipper/consignee's laden container is stored at carrier's terminal facilities before vessel's departure or after vessel's arrival.

2. Calculation of detention and demurrage

<EXPORT>

Detention: It is counted from the day of empty container pick-up to the day of laden container return (both days inclusive)

Demurrage: It is counted from the day of laden return to the day of CY closing (both days inclusive)

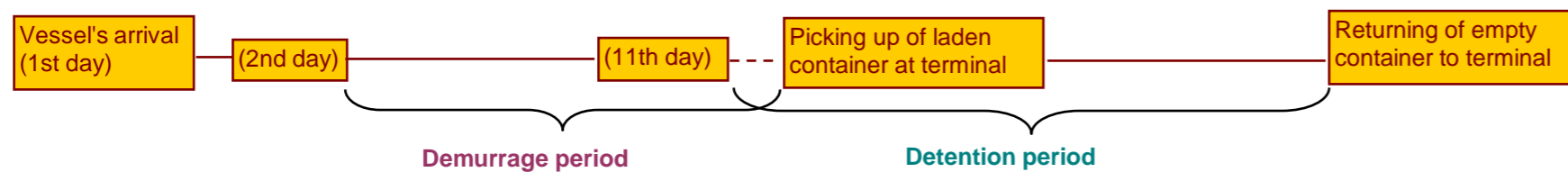


<IMPORT>

Detention: It is counted from the day of laden pick-up to the day of empty return (both days inclusive).

If the laden container is picked up after the freetime demurrage period of 10 days, detention period will be counted from 11th days of vessel's arrival.

Demurrage: It is counted from the NEXT day of vessel's arrival (if the arrival time is not 0:00) to the day of empty return (both days inclusive)



* The above free time includes Sundays and public holidays.

*Detention or demurrage day/days after free time listed above is/are subject to overtime charge.
